HOW TO GET THERE:

Turn off Bruce Highway Qld, 55kms south of Rockhampton and 50kms north of Gladstone - (Drive, Fly-Drive)

PLACE:

RULES OF ENTRY

FIREARMS:

All entrants must hold a current A&B Category Firearms Licence.

All entrants must supply their own firearms, as firearms are not supplied at this event.

Minimum calibre 6mm/.243cal and maximum calibre .338Win Mag for the centrefire event.

To keep this event as realistic as possible the following parameters are set for safety, fairness and the comfort of others.

The rules of the Range have to be complied with and will be briefed on the morning of the 24th June, 2017 prior to the event starting.

All centrefire rifles should be zeroed for 300 metres as there is no time allocated for sighting in.

This is a cold barrel event to demonstrate the rifles point of impact as it were in the field.

For the courtesy of other entrants no muzzle brakes will be allowed.

Shooting position either prone with the use of a bipod or shooting sticks (to be supplied by entrant).

This is a hunting rifle event, this includes long range hunting rifles with a magazine capacity greater than one round (other than factory rifles eg: Ruger No1 etc.)

Entrants with benchrest or target rifles will face a penalty.

All rifles will need to be secured within entrants vehicle as there is minimum safe facilities at the Range.

AMMUNITION:

Rimfire ammunition (22lr) will be supplied, this is to keep this event as fair as possible.

All centrefire ammunition is to be supplied by the entrant.

PRIZES:

Trophies will be presented to entrants that shoot the tightest group within the designated area of the target in both the Rimfire and Centrefire events, first, second and third prize.

PRIZE POOL:

To be advised and will be drawn out of a hat at the completion of all events.
