To be eligible for subsidies funding you must meet the following:

 Applicants must be 15 years or older, not currently in school, and a permanent resident of Queensland. They must be an Australian citizen, permanent resident, temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits, or a New Zealand citizen. Additionally, they should not hold a qualification higher than a Certificate IV and must not be enrolled in another course.

Individuals undertaking training must contribute to their training costs through a cocontribution fee. Estimated Fee of \$1000.00, payable over 4 Instalments. This is determined upon your enrolment and concessional status.
